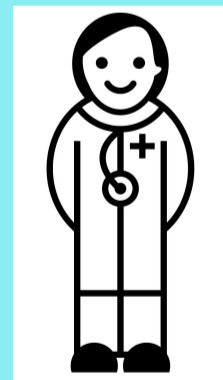
Keynote Speaker
